

## KS1

### Foundation Stage:

We will consolidate our learning to date by practising the vocabulary with songs and rhymes. We will continue to practise numbers to 5 and learn numbers to 12 and colours, which will be used to describe classroom objects. We will learn verbs of movement and some body parts by recognition to join in playground games in French.

### Year 1:

The children will be learning vocabulary related to houses, pirates and farm animals. We will describe nouns according to size and colour. The children will practise numbers to 20 consecutively and out of sequence. We will learn vocabulary and traditions related to Easter in France.

### Year 2:

This term the children will be learning the months of the year, days of the week and how to describe birthdays in French. We will continue to build on their excellent number knowledge in a variety of ways. We will explore the story “Jack and the Beanstalk” in French and many familiar rhymes and songs. We will learn vocabulary related to Easter.

## KS2 Topics

### Year 3:

This term the children will be learning vocabulary related to classroom equipment and furniture, the home, rooms and furnishings. We will learn how to describe the position of furniture and objects and the use of “my” related to known nouns while recognising masculine and feminine nouns.

### Year 4:

We will be learning how to describe animals and their habitats. The children will name jungle, farm, sea animals and pets. They will use familiar sentence structures with the new vocabulary and practise verbs of movement appropriate to particular creatures. The children will also learn how to construct negative statements/sentences.

### Year 5:

This term our topic will be clothing and seasonal activities consolidating our work on weather. We will also explore the vocabulary related to jobs and professions focusing on masculine and feminine roles/descriptions. We will explore numbers to 1,000 in a variety of ways and the topic of Easter. The children will practice translating familiar written language in to English.

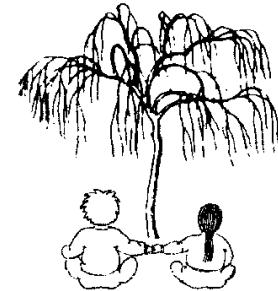
### Year 6:

We will be learning about shops and shopping this term. The children will practice making reservations in French and learning about Euros. We will also explore the layout of a town in respect of directions, civic buildings and shops, which the children will describe. The children will have the opportunity to use dictionaries and explore comprehension passages in French related to this topic. We will explore Easter traditions and stories.
