

KS1

Foundation Stage:

This term the children will learn vocabulary related to farm animals and pets.

We will practise colours on the interactive whiteboard. The children will also learn numbers to 12 in activities related to classroom objects and animals. The children will play Simon Says in French using action verbs and body parts from Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes.

Year 1:

We will learn numbers to 20 and practise them with songs and sequencing activities. We will learn Old Macdonald has a farm and associated vocabulary. We will learn and play The Farmers in his den in French. We will look at the topic of pirates and princesses and continue to use adjectives of size and colour with our new topics.

Year 2:

The children will learn numbers to 39, which will be practised in a variety of ways. We will learn days of the week and months of the year. New vocabulary will be related to clothing and weather. The children will learn and memorise a rhyme using pictures as prompts to be recited as a whole class. We will learn French nursery rhymes with actions.

KS2 Topics

Year 3:

This term we will be learning about our classroom, identifying the features of the room and classroom objects. We will practise putting this vocabulary in to sentences using adjectives of size and colour and position words.

We will learn how to describe our homes in respect of rooms and furniture and make simple sentences with this vocabulary. We will learn about Easter in France.

Year 4:

This term we will be learning about animals and their habitats and how to describe them physically and in terms of how they move. We will read “les quatre amis” a story on the interactive story and work towards performing it with actions in groups. We will learn how to make negative statements and sentences using the new topic vocabulary.

Year 5:

We will be learning how to describe the weather and seasons. We will learn the vocabulary related to clothing and make complex sentences using the weather, season, clothing vocabulary and previously learned vocabulary and verbs related to activities.

We will learn and use numbers up to 1,000 with maths in French. We will revise

vocabulary related to sports and research the Olympic Sports of 2012.

Year 6:

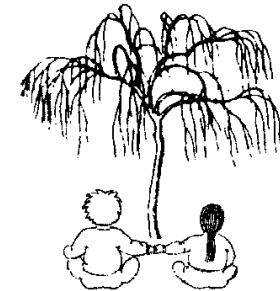
We will be learning about French towns, traditional shops and buildings. We will research authentic maps of French towns to identify features and known vocabulary in preparation for designing their own French towns.

The children will translate passages about shopping, money, towns and rural areas using dictionaries and known language. The children will combine number knowledge with speaking and written tasks related to shopping.
